Uncontrollable items that impacted the budget and tax increases

- * CLA % decreased from 96.66% to 89.47% causing approximately an 8% increase in taxes (which is around an \$0.11 cent increase)
- * FY 2024/2025 Tax Rate if CLA had remained @ 96.66% = \$1.3883
- * We lost \$60,000 in revenue from the small schools grant due to weighting calculations
- * The SU assessment increased over \$50,000 this year
- * Insurance premiums increased by 16.4%

Surplus Fund Balance = \$57,354.00

There was a fund balance of \$57,354.00, which was applied in full to revenues to offset tax increases.

All of our students participate in either math intervention or enrichment three days a week. With the help of our new school counselor, we are meeting the social and emotional needs of all our students.

This year we are fully staffed at Readsboro and were able to meet our students needs academically, socially, and emotionally in all areas. We are very proud of this as last year the town voiced their concerns that we were not able to do this given the prior year staffing shortages.

Facility Maintenance Updates

Over the last year we have worked to maintain our school building. We have replaced faucets and soap dispensers on all restroom sinks, replaced old smoke and heat sensors throughout the building, painted hallways and restrooms, converted to all LED lighting, upgraded cameras and security, and signed a contract for a new heating system to be installed over the summer (we were awarded approximately \$100,000 grant for this purpose).
